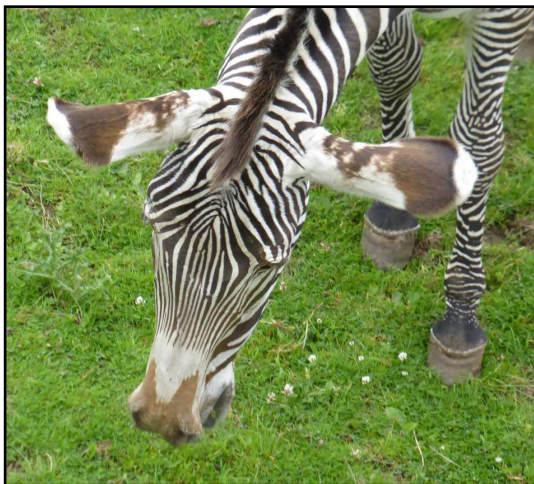
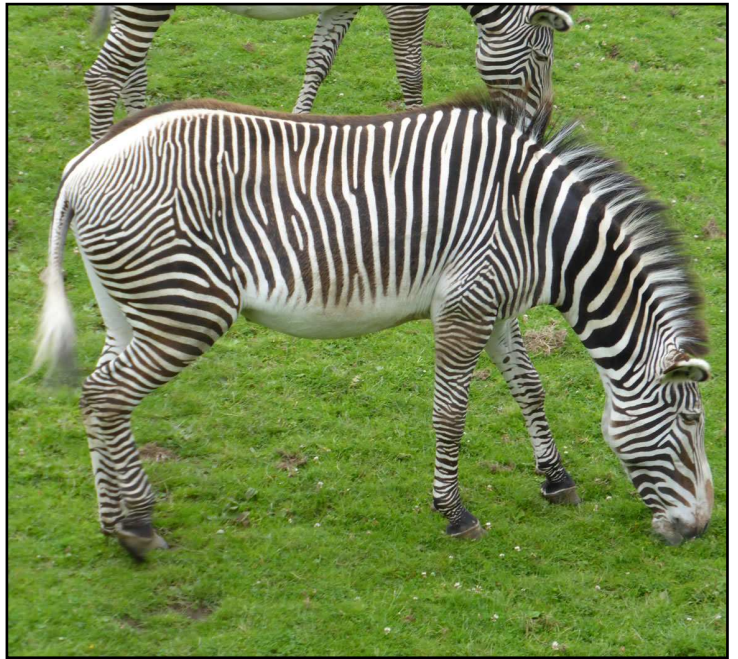


Zebras live in Africa. The zebra's black and white stripes make it easy for us to spot. Each zebra has a different pattern of stripes. A zebra has large ears which are upright when they are calm and laid back when they are angry. The eyes are on the side of the zebra's head.



Baby zebras can stand up and walk 20 minutes after being born. They drink their mother's milk for up to a year. Adult zebras do not eat meat, they eat grass and leaves. They live for up to 25 years.

Zebras live in families and take care of each other. The main dangers to zebras are lions and hyenas which will kill and eat them. They can run away quickly to keep out of danger.
